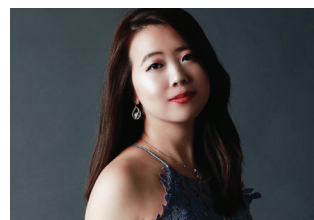
ALMANOVA DUO JULY 18 • SATURDAY • 3 PM
